Abstract. The abstract (100 – 300 words with 6 key words) should be sent by e-mail to quaestus.ucdctm@gmail.com. The abstract should include title, name(s) of author(s), affiliation and e-mail addresses. Abstract must be typed in Times New Roman, font size: 12, single spaced. **Deadline for sending the abstracts: 20th January 2014.**

Accepted papers must be sent by 3rd March 2014. The length of the final paper should be no more than 12 pages in A4 size, including figures, tables and references.

Papers will be submitted in English.

Please observe the following guidelines:

- ▲ Microsoft Word: Margins: Top: 2.2 cm; Left: 1.8 cm; Bottom: 2.2 cm; Right: 1.8 cm;
- ▲ Font: Times New Roman; font size: 12; line spacing: single;
- ▲ Indicate the source of quotation between parentheses: (Smith 2010: 12);
- ▲ Do not insert page numbers;
- ▲ References: ordered alphabetically: surname, name, year of publication, title in italics, town, publishing house. Examples:
 - One author

 - Two authors

PAPER REVIEW PROCESS

All contributions must follow academic writing, structure and methodology. Submissions will be blind-refereed by two reviewers who will decide if the proposed paper will be accepted or not.

Submissions are judged on overall quality, contribution to the topic and originality. The selected papers will be published in the Quaestus Journal (indexed in the RePEc – EconPapers and DOAJ databases, ISSN 2285-424X, ISSN online 2343-8134) or in the conference volume (*Tourism and Durable Development*, ISSN 2286-3125).
